The NZ Road Transport Industry Awards recognise and honour an individual, organisation or company that has gone above and beyond industry requirements in raising skills, safety practises, knowledge, training, innovation and expertise. The awards will honour activities and achievements that ultimately improve the daily lives of people in the industry making it a rewarding and safe environment to work in.

 - **Outstanding Contribution to Training**
 - **Outstanding Contribution to Health and Safety**
 - **Industry Innovation**

What the judges are looking for?

Companies or Individuals who have made an exceptional contribution to some aspect of the road transport industry by way of innovation, technology, safety, and training or implemented processes that have had a positive outcome on staff and/or customers.

Your Business Description

Clearly outline your core business focus. Include some background on your business, how long you have been in business. Tell us why you could be the Supreme winner.

Your key points of difference

- Do you have a product or service that makes you stand out?
- Are your training programs working?
- Why do you think they are working?
- What's special?
- Do you have any positive outcomes from your innovation or training?

Key Characteristics of Your Business

- Business objectives that have been achieved in the previous year
 - Innovative initiatives that have been successfully employed
 - Unique organisational policies – internal and/or external benefits
 - Branding/marketing behaviour that reinforces positive social values

Award Categories Details

Supreme Contribution to New Zealand Road Transport Award Criteria

Any activity or achievement within the industry will be eligible for the award including (but not exclusively) any of the following:

- Actions or activities which enhance the public standing of the industry
- Positive advancement of the industry's values amongst staff and/or customers
- Mentoring of colleagues and staff within an organisation or across the industry as a whole
- Long-term commitment to the road transport industry and contribution to its ongoing success

The nomination should also specify:

- The challenges and degree of difficulty faced in achieving the outcome

- The time and effort involved in working towards the outcome
- The length of time the nominee has been involved in the road transport industry and any other actions or activities over that time which have also made a contribution to the road transport industry

The winners of the training, innovation and health and safety awards will also be considered for the Supreme Award.

Outstanding Contribution to Health and Safety Award Criteria

Any activity or achievement within the industry will be eligible for the award including (but not exclusively) any of the following:

- Development and inception of health and safety innovations or programmes which have demonstrably improved the health and safety performance of an organisation or company, either individually or with other organisations or companies
- Promotion of the need for effective health and safety programmes within the industry
- Encouragement of the merits of active health and safety interventions within an organisation or company

The nomination should also specify:

- The challenges and degree of difficulty faced in achieving the outcome
 - Measurable ways in which the activity caused an improved health and safety environment and/or outcomes
 - The time and effort involved in working towards the outcome
 - The length of time the nominee has been involved in the road transport industry and any other actions or activities over that time which have also made a contribution to the road transport industry

Outstanding Contribution to Training Award Criteria

Any activity or achievement within the industry will be eligible for the award including (but not exclusively) any of the following:

- Successful promotion of the benefits of participation in a training programme or programmes to individuals, whether already in the industry or outsiders
- Successful promotion of the benefits of providing a training programme to organisations and companies involved in the industry
- Provision of training opportunities either on an individual basis or within a company or organisation and encouragement for those training opportunities to be taken up
- An innovative approach to the promotion or provision of training opportunities
- Promotion or inception of a successful training relationship between an outside organisation, education provider and an association organization.

The nomination should also specify:

- The challenges and degree of difficulty faced in achieving the outcome
- The time and effort involved in working towards the outcome
- The length of time the nominee has been involved in the road transport industry and any other actions or activities over that time which have also made a signal contribution to the road transport industry
- Measurable evidence of an improved safety environment and/or performance either within an organisation or company or the industry as a whole

Industry Innovation Award Criteria

Any activity or achievement within the industry will be eligible for the award including (but not exclusively) any of the following:

- Technical or mechanical innovations with demonstrable commercial applications that improve efficiency, safety and/or increase cost efficiency
- Managerial or organisational innovations that result in improved business processes and/or more efficient handling of goods, improved client relations, or any other aspects of a business's operation
- Encouragement or promotion of the benefits of innovative systems within an organisation or company or the industry as a whole.

The nomination should also specify:

- The challenges and degree of difficulty faced in achieving the outcome
- Measurable ways in which the activity caused an improved health and safety environment and/or outcomes
- The time and effort involved in working towards the outcome
- The length of time the nominee has been involved in the road transport industry and any other actions or activities over that time which have also made a contribution to the road transport industry

Judging Panel

The panel of judges will be made industry leaders and sponsor representatives. Judges decision will be final.
